NDC team visits BRRRI

A 78-member-team of National Defence Course (NDC) led by Air Commodore M Mortuza Kamal from Mirpur Cantonment, Dhaka visited Bangladesh Rice Research Institute (BRRRI) on Wednesday (18 April 2018) in Gazipur.
